The "Bowl of Hygeia Award for Outstanding Community Service in Pharmacy" program is now entering its 46th year of operation. 4. *The recipient is not currently serving, nor has he/she served within the immediate past two years as an officer of the Association, in other than an ex-officio capacity, or its awards committee.*
5. *The recipient has compiled an outstanding record of community service, which, apart from his/her specific identification as a pharmacist, reflects well on the profession.*

2009 Pharmacist of the Year
