### HEALTH-SYSTEM PHARMACIST OF THE YEAR

Presented to a member in recognition of:

1. Significant contributions to the profession of pharmacy and health-system practice over the past twelve to twenty-four months
2. Development and implementation of advanced health-system pharmacy practice programs, research, and/or publications
3. Personal enrichment endeavors through specialized training and advanced degrees
4. Active membership in the TSHP
5. Demonstrated leadership qualities

### INNOVATIVE HEALTH-SYSTEM PHARMACY PRACTICE
