Are you a pharmacist providing immunizations or CLIA-waived testing services?

If so, you must have live OSHA training every year.

OSHA's fines for non-compliance can exceed **\$90,000**.

You can comply with OSHA's training requirements online for **\$25**.

(You do the math.)

Even if you participate in an OSHA training program every year, you are not in compliance with OSHA's requirements if the training doesn't have a LIVE component. In response to requests from Tennessee's pharmacists, the Tennessee Pharmacists Research and Education Foundation (TPREF) is offering an ACPE-accredited OSHA training webinar that meets all of OSHA's training requirements. The 2009 OSHA Update can protect your pharmacy against potentially devastating OSHA fines—and your pharmacy can keep protecting the public against potentially devastating disease.

The **webinar program** is presented online by Stephan Foster, Pharm.D., FAPhA. Dr. Foster is a retired Captain in the U.S. Public Health Service and is on faculty at the University of Tennessee College of Pharmacy.
