For plan year 2017, Humana Pharmacy Solutions is offering a new quality-based network that rewards pharmacies on performance and establishes their pharmacy in-network/preferred for PDP/MAPD plans.

Being part of the Rx Quality Network is as easy as 1-2-3

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2017 CMS Part D stars adherence measures*

Quality rewards are based on achievement of CMS defined proportion of days covered (PDC) goals for targeted drug classes.

- **Non-insulin diabetes medications** (including biguanides, sulfonylureas, DPP-IV inhibitors, TZDs, incretin mimetics, meglitinides and SGLT2 inhibitors)
- **Renin angiotensin system (RAS) antagonists** (including ACE inhibitors, ARBs and direct renin inhibitors)
- **Statins**

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EQuIPP™ tracking

No additional data requirements are needed. The quality reward will be based on data captured within the EQuIPP platform.

- **Star measure scores for pharmacies** are calculated accurately and consistently across plans/PBMs
- **Provides transparency into the PDC scores** for each adherence measure

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Earn rewards based on quality performance

The PDC threshold is the level above which the medication has a reasonable likelihood of achieving the most clinical benefit; clinical evidence provides support for a standard PDC threshold of 80 percent.

- **\$5 is withheld** for each Medicare pharmacy claim
- **\$2, \$6 payback opportunity** for each Medicare pharmacy claim based on performance

- **If the pharmacy fails to hit 50th percentile** of PDC, there will be **no payback**



- **If the pharmacy hits 50th percentile** of PDC, payback will be \$2 of the \$5 collected



- **If the pharmacy hits 80th percentile** of PDC, payback will be the entire \$5 collected plus \$1, for a total payback of \$6
